

Machine Shop Acknowledgement of Risk

a student enrolled at the University of British Columbia (the “University”) do hereby ACKNOWLEDGE:

1. that the Department’s Machine Shop Facilities (the “Shops”) are an inherently dangerous place and due care and attention are required when using the facilities for my own safety and for the safety of my fellow students and Shop personnel.
2. that all students who use the Shops must have undertaken the Department’s Machine Shop Orientation Course (the “Orientation Course”). In particular, I am aware that it is necessary to receive appropriate instruction from qualified Shop personnel before using any Shop tool or equipment with which I am unfamiliar.
3. that unqualified persons are not permitted in the Shops and are not permitted to use any Shop tools or equipment.
4. that entry into or use of the Shops and of Shop tools involves exposure to certain inherent risks, including but not limited to potential injury or death.
5. that the University carries no personal property, medical, dental or any accident benefit/disability insurance on my behalf and that it is my sole responsibility to ensure that I maintain sufficient personal insurance coverage.
6. that my use of the Shops and Shop tools is for fulfillment of course requirements or graduate studies research only, unless I agree to and sign the Machine Shop Waiver and Indemnification Agreement.
7. that the Shop Lecturer may suspend my Shop privileges at any time and at his/her sole discretion by giving verbal notice and such a suspension is immediately effective.
